St. John de Brébeuf, (1593-1649) was ordained at thirty-three and was the first Jesuit Missionary in Huronia (1626). He worked throughout all the district, founding Mission outposts and converting thousands to the faith. He inspired many Jesuits to volunteer for the Missions of New France. Massive in body, strong yet gentle in character, his visions of the cross and of his future martyrdom were fulfilled when he was captured on March 16, 1649. He was martyred at St. Ignace, six miles from Ste. Marie at the age of fifty-six. Brebeuf is said to have the heart of a giant. He was known as the apostle of the Hurons. The Indians called him Echon. In Canada his feast is celebrated together with the St. Isaac Jogues and the Canadian Martyrs on September 26.

Academic Standards

St. John Brebeuf School has high academic standards offering the Kindergarten to Grade 8 curriculum established by Manitoba Education and Training. All teachers are certified and bring a commitment to integrate faith with teaching.



The learning environment in the school is both positive and happy. In partnership with parents, all our students are encouraged to reach their full academic potential.

The kindergarten program operates weekday mornings providing students with structured and play-oriented learning activities. The Early Years teachers work as a team to provide a stimulating program for our Kindergarten to Grade 3 students.



St. John Brebeuf School has a full time resource teacher who works closely with teachers to offer support to children requiring extra help as well as for those children who are ready for enrichment. The school also has specialized teachers for physical education, music and technology training.

The school music program provides an opportunity for students to grow and develop their creativity. The classroom program involves students in a variety of musical elements and techniques. Extracurricular activities provide opportunities for students to participate in choir and perform at various events outside the school.
